## Punghing System:

Sportident with Air+ will be used as punching and timing system. Sportident classic punching can be used.

There are no SIACs available for renting (only classical Sicards can be rented).

### Start and Finish procedure:

Starting zone procedure

- 3 Call, Clear, Check and SIAC Test
- 2 Description Point
- 1 Map Delivery
- Arrival Zone Procedure

The arrival time will be taken by inserting the sicard (either traditional or

SIAC) in the FINISH station on the arrival line.

### **Prize Giving Ceremony:**

**Stage 1:** Prizes will be awarded to the first classified in each classes (except for direct and beginner classes)

#### Stage 2,3,4 :

Prizes will be awarded to the first three classified in W21E and M21E in each day

For the Mediterranean Champioships Orienteering (only countries members of COMOF) will be awarded with special medals and diplomas the first six classified in W20, M20, W21E and M21E in each day.

#### At the end of stage 4:

On the classes M21E and W21E will be awarded the first 6 positions on the sum of the times of the stage 2, 3 and 4.

On the classes MW12, MW14, MW16, MW18, MW20, MW21A, MW21B, MW21C, MW35, MW40, MW45, MW50, MW55, MW60, MW65, MW70, MW75, will be awarded the first 3 positions on the times sum of stages 2,3,4.

On the classes MWA, MWB, MWC will be awarded the first position on the times sum of stages 2,3 e 4.

There will be no prizes for direct and beginner classes.

At the end of each stage, all MW10 partecipants and the Beginners participants born after 01/01/2014 will receive a participation prize.

Sprint Night race (for competitive classes)

#### Start

First start at 5.30 p.m. (for the competitive classes)

Free start with corridors, it will follow a scheme of routes combined with the race categories. Start will be nearby to the arena. Headlamp is recommended

Beginner, M10, W10, Direct and School categories will have a free start with punching start from 4 p.m. to 5.p.m. (no night race)

#### **Control Description**

The control description will be only on the map.

#### Fair Play

The maps will not be collected after the race so please do not show the map to the runners who haven't yet started, or else you might be disqualified.

#### Withdrawal and maximun time

Competitors wishing to withdraw must cross the finish line (to switch off their SIAC). The maximum time limit is 1 hour. After 1 hour from the last start, the controls points will be collected.

#### **Prize Giving Ceremony**

The prize-giving ceremony will take place the following day (1 November) before the prizegiving ceremony of the Sprint race in Prato.



# Stage 2 - I November - Prato - Sprint Distance

Sprint race. Mixed terrain 90% urban, 10% meadows and fields. Recommended running or trail shoes.

Competitors wishing to withdraw must cross the finish line (to switch off their SIAC). The maximum time limit is 1 hour. After 1 hour from the last start, the controls points will be collected.


#### **MEMORIAL STELVIO MANFRIN:**



About 40 years ago Stelvio Manfrin created the Monteferrato map. It would have been the location for the first Italian Cup played in Tuscany. From then on the orienteering movement would also take off in this enchanting region. Stelvio has been missing for 3 years now, but this event allows us to still have him among us, remembering his commitment and passion for this wonderful woodland sport.



#### **MEMORIAL SERGIO GRIFONI:**



He first encountered Orienteering in the 1960s while he was in Halden, Norway, working on a nuclear project. It was his Norwegian colleagues who invited him, after work, to try orienteering: they would run with black-and-white maps at a 1:25,000 scale, with a few checkpoints, navigating from one point to another without too many details. Sergio enjoyed it a lot, and when he returned to ENEA, at the historic Casaccia headquarters in Rome, he involved his colleagues from the sports club in organizing races in the Agro Romano area, near their workplace. They were few but determined; the maps were either from the IGM (Military Geographic Institute) or hand-drawn, and there was a strong competitive spirit. Soon, a small internal championship was established, but having fun was the priority.

From this initial group, the ENEA CASACCIA Club was born.

Meanwhile, orienteering was also developing in Trentino, and many clubs were founded. Sergio became involved in the new Federation, first as a board member and later as President from 2008 to 2012.

During this period, he pursued one of his most important projects: the creation of the Confederation of Mediterranean countries. On November 12, 2010, in Venice, with Italy, Serbia, and Spain present (and Turkey joining shortly after), the Confederation of Mediterranean Orienteering Federations was established, which now counts 13 member countries.

At the same time, Sergio contributed to the work of the IOF (International Orienteering Federation) as a member of the map commission and as a FISO (Italian Orienteering Federation) delegate at numerous assemblies.

He played technical roles in many national and international competitions, acting as Course Planner, Race Director, or Delegate, both in foot orienteering and Ski-O (ski orienteering).

Even when these roles became less frequent, Sergio never stopped promoting the sport, organizing school courses, printing maps, and setting up races for schools.

Sergio is no longer with us, but his commitment and passion for orienteering remain.
